

Deaf-Blind Support Foundation Con-nection – a non-governmental charitable foundation created for the purpose of systematic changes in the field of support and social integration of people with simultaneous impairment of vision and hearing. Established on April 8, 2014, at the meeting of the National Council of the Strategic Initiatives Agency.

The activities of the Foundation are systematic and complex: from genetic research to the development of inclusive theater.



Factors affecting the development strategy of the Foundation





The evolution of the environment over the next five years will entail a further increase in the number of children with severe multiple disabilities, including impaired hearing and vision.

In the case of senile deafness, we will also come to a qualitatively different generation of people over 60 years old who adapt faster and are more advanced in the use of various 2

Technical devices are being developed in the world and in Russia that help people with hearing and vision impairments. One more step will be taken to replace the lost functions of the body or supplement them with the help of modern technologies.



The possible change of priorities of state policy and business are the elements of reducing sustainability for charitable activities.

But despite this, it is realistic to almost completely satisfy the request from the deafblind people to the state in key areas of concern.

Main activities of the foundation





To create mechanisms that meet the needs of the deafblind people (learning, employment, support, leisure and selfrealization, family)

To create a career guidance system, train at least 500 deafblind people

To create a family assistance system in which the 80% of the families who need help are covered by Community projects, form local communities around regional offices

To implement applied and fundamental projects aimed at restoring hearing and vision

To implement the social integration of deafblind people through participation in social

To ensure a high level of public awareness about deafblind people and recognition of the Foundation's subsidiaries in the Russian Federation

An educational license has been obtained, development roadmap was made, an electronic library of deafblindness resources has been updated

Diagnostic training

Specialists from 12 regions are trained in diagnostic training, training methods are verified, a roadmap of their transfer to the state as part of the "Early Aid" program was made

Conferences

A conference was held in Novosibirsk in partnership with the university

Work with young scientists

An international conference of young scientists was held (preconference of young deafblind)

At least 250 people are continuously trained in the Academy

In 30 regions, a diagnostic training system was introduced, in 20, a system for diagnosing the deafblind potential was introduced.

A conference was held in one of the main regions of the country

Youth Conference was held under the auspices of the DBI and with the funding from this organization

Courses within the Academy work successfully and are in demand in the professional community (500 people are continuously trained)

"Perkins" Program

A financial model for the development of resource centers in the regions and training on adapted Perkins modules was created, specialists were trained in accordance with the Perkins program, the first internship in the Netherlands was arranged

Teacher training completed in agreement with Perkins International, 40 "gurus" was trained

45 "gurus" are ready to work in the regions on the topic of deaf-blindness, the Academy implements its own courses based on the Perkins program and the infrastructure created within it.

Education

Training programs for volunteers and young scientists are implemented in 5 countries according to the Foundation methods, stages for the "Mentors and Students" programs are developed, young scientists enrolled in the program work within the "Mother's school" project

3 specialists received a candidates of sciences degree, at least 3 doctoral students are being supported, the developed concept of the Alumni Association is being implemented (at least 3 online and 1 offline events per year)

There is a full-fledged community of graduates of the Academy's programs and youth projects (alumni association), there are 10 candidates of science and 1 doctor of science on deafblindness in the country

Career guidance

Pilot career guidance project was implemented, development model of entrepreneurial skills for deafblind people are tested.

Professional community has certified deaf-blind career guidance methods, 250 deafblind persons took part in the Career and Employment Program

Deaf-blind career guidance methods has been introduced into the state education, labor and employment systems, 500 deafblind persons took part in the Career and Employment Program

Technologies

An organization for the commercialization of development Charlie and Robin devices; more than 50 devices are in use with the target audience; a professional version of See My World application for doctors has been released.

More than 500 "Charlie" and "Robin" devices are used by the the target audience; more than 10% of ophthalmologic clinics in Russia use "See My World"; 15% of the investment returned in the form donations

Developed a fundamental new generation of basic products ("Charlie", "Robin", etc.); devices are available in most developed countries and the target audience exceeds 5,000; a telemedicine project in the field of ophthalmology (Al-diagnostics) was implemented; 50% of investments returned in the form of donations.

Research

A study was conducted in the field of studying the tactile perception of the blind with the help of EEG (at least 10 participants); a scientific research study was conducted in the field of cortical prosthetics (a detailed TOR for R & D has been developed).

At least 6 master's and 2 master's scientific works are defended on the subject of the Laboratory activities

Rehabilitation

A course on modern assistive technologies and methods for the restoration of hearing and vision has been developed for specialists working with deafblind people (video lectures and methodological materials have been published).

Rehabilitation programs have been developed for deafblind and blind people who restored their vision with the methods of gene therapy and prosthetics (an integrated approach of work together with subsidiaries)

The laboratory is the center of competence for specialists on the topic of rehabilitation of the deafblind with the help of high-tech medical and assistive technologies (implementation programs, methodological materials and video courses are regularly updated)
